## DRAFT HORSES

### Rules:

- Entries Close—As soon as our stalls are filled, the entries will close, but no later than August 31st, 2018.
- Entry Fee—\$15.00 per head
- In Place—All animals must be in place by Sunday, September 23rd at Noon. Stalls will be ready Saturday morning, September 22rd.
- Judging times are as follows:
  - Draft Horses, Halter Classes—Monday, September 24th at 3:00 p.m.
  - Draft Horses, Hitch Classes—Tuesday, September 25th at 1:00 p.m. in Show Arena. Must be hitched to a suitable wheeled vehicle.
- Removal— After 10:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 25th. Draft horses may remain for the week if space is available.
- All horses entered, except geldings, must be eligible to entry in a recognized Stud book. Exhibitors must be prepared to furnish Certificate of Registry of animals over one year of age.
- Limit 2 entries per class per exhibitor.
- All equidae, except foals less than six (6) months and nursing their dam, must present proof of a negative coggins test to Equine Superintendent.
