- Entries Close—When stalls are filled, but not later than August 31st, 2018.
- Entry Fee—\$7.00 per head
- In Place—Ponies must be in place by Sunday, September 23rd at Noon.
- Judging times are for the following:
  - Pony Halter Classes—Sections 1-6—Tuesday, September 25th at 9:00 a.m. Judging order will follow the Premium listing starting with Sec. 1.
  - Haflinger Pony Hitches—Section 9 ONLY—Tuesday, September 25th at 1 p.m. with draft horse and mule hitches in the show arena.
  - Pony Carts, Hitches & Special Pony Youth— Sections 7 & 8—Wednesday, September 26th at 1:00 p.m.
- Removal—No animal removed before 10:00 p.m. on closing day of fair.
- The age of ponies shall be computed from January 1st.
- The Society will not furnish hay or bedding for stock.
- All ponies must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of making entry.
- No animal can be shown in more than one class except that single entries may also complete in spans, and under saddle.
- All animals shown must be sound, and free from blemish and score a minimum of three (3) on the equine health scale.
- No Premium will be awarded when the animal is not worthy, even though there may be no other competition.
- Equine Activity Liability Waiver must be signed by all participants.
- The Fair reserves the right to limit the number of entries per exhibitor based on available stall space.
- All equidae, except foals under six (6) months and nursing their dam, must present proof of a negative test to Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test conducted within the previous 12 months. An official EIA laboratory report constitutes such proof. Have paper checked prior to unloading. Refer to the MDARD Health Requirements on page 8 of the Premium Book.
- Exhibitor numbers to be issued day of show.
- No cross entry between pony show and registered Haflinger Horse show allowed.

## DRAFT HORSES

### Rules:

- Entries Close—As soon as our stalls are filled, the entries will close, but no later than August 31st, 2018.
- Entry Fee—\$15.00 per head
- In Place—All animals must be in place by Sunday, September 23rd at Noon. Stalls will be ready Saturday morning, September 22nd.
- Judging times are as follows:
  - Draft Horses, Halter Classes—Monday, September 24th at 3:00 p.m.
  - Draft Horses, Hitch Classes—Tuesday, September 25th at 1:00 p.m. in Show Arena. Must be hitched to a suitable wheeled vehicle.
- Removal— After 10:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 25th. Draft horses may remain for the week if space is available.
- All horses entered, except geldings, must be eligible to entry in a recognized Stud book. Exhibitors must be prepared to furnish Certificate of Registry of animals over one year of age.
- Limit 2 entries per class per exhibitor.
- All equidae, except foals less than six (6) months and nursing their dam, must present proof of a negative coggins test to Equine Superintendent.
